

## **Commercial Photography and Filming Rules (as PDF)**

Because Vizcaya is a National Historic Landmark and a museum that welcomes the public daily, we must ask our photo clients to help us care for our property and our other guests. We appreciate your adherence to the following rules:

To allow for the enjoyment of all visitors to Vizcaya, we ask that no shooting take place in the following locations:

- Inside the Main House,
- inside the gates of the swimming pool area
- Café & Shop area.
- In front of the Main House (west façade and main drive) between 9:30 am and 5:00 pm.

It is important that crew and talent not touch, move or attach anything to statues, fountains, other art objects. All props must be free-standing.

We are not able to provide dressing rooms. If you choose to use a motor home for dressing, parking will be assigned by Vizcaya security staff on the day of the shoot.

While shooting in the public areas, please do not leave make-up bags, lights and props strewn about the area. We also ask that crew and talent not block access to doorways, gates, ramps or stairs. Crew and talent must be fully clothed while on the property. Shoes and shirts are required

Please do not post signage on the property, including the parking lot and South Miami Avenue.

Sets may not be constructed on the property, nor the use of paint.

No animals may be brought on the property.

The only restrooms available to all photography and film customers are those on the south side of the service area. The Café and Shop restrooms are not available for use by photo crews.

Photographers and their customers must comply with any direction given by Vizcaya staff. Any photographer disregarding the above rules will be asked to leave.
